What Does The Bible Say About...

What Is The Church?

The title may seem like an odd question, but think about how many perceive the church: a building to go to (or to avoid because I don't need a building to be religious!), a varied group of organizations that pick and choose what to teach or practices (usually in an effort to please the populace where they are). But is that what the Lord desires us to think of when we consider the church? Let's look and see what God's Word says about this. The Bible tells us that the church is...

An eternally purposed body. It is the church that shows forth "the manifold wisdom of God, according to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Ephesians 3:10-11).

A body built by the Lord Himself. Jesus said, "I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18).

Purchased by the blood of Christ. Elders are commanded "to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood" (Acts 20:28).

The body of our Lord. Christ is "the head over all things to the church, Which is his body" (Ephesians 1:22-23).

The kingdom of our Lord. Those in the church are said to have been "translated ... into the kingdom of his dear Son" (Colossians 1:13).

The body of the saved, those baptized for the remission of sins. On the day of Pentecost those that "gladly received his word were baptized... and the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved" (Acts 2:37-47).

The body that will be delivered to heaven upon Christ's return at the end.

"Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God" (1 Corinthians 15:24).

Knowing these things, perhaps we will all think more highly of the church of our Lord than so many worldly individuals do. Perhaps we will give greater consideration to the church of which we are a part, making sure it is the one He built and purchased with His blood... the one which will enter that heavenly home He has prepared.

"What Must I Do To Be Saved?"

*The greatest question we may ask is answered plainly in God's Word. God encourages us to be noble enough to examine these teachings (**Acts 17:11**) and then to love Him enough to obey them (**John 14:15**).*

- I may only come to Him through Christ (**Hebrews 5:9; John 14:6**).
- I must have faith that comes through study of His Word (**Hebrews 11:6; Romans 10:17**).
- I must repent of my sins (**Acts 2:38; 17:30**).
- I must confess Him before others (Acts 8:36-37; Romans 10:9-10).
- I must be baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21).
- I must live faithfully to His Word (1 John 1:5-9; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Revelation 2:10).

Improvements Are Needed.

One of the best ways to improve the world is to improve ourselves. Often, we are so busy trying to improve others, that we overlook our own need. I am not implying that we are not to help others (Gal. 6:1). However, I strongly believe that we must examine ourselves from time-to-time and observe the areas wherein we can make improvements. Improvement comes when we honestly look at ourselves as God sees us (James 1:23-25).
