INTRODUCTION:

A. Text: Psalm 86:12.

1. One of my favorite songs is ***Glory To His Name***.
2. "Glory" in the N/T means *to honor* someone's reputation or their name.
 - 1) **Psalm 86:9.**
 - 2) **1 Corinthians 1:31.**

B. Stanza 1: We glorify His name because of His cleansing blood.

1. Jesus died on the cross: **Philippians 2:8.**
2. This made cleansing possible: **Ephesians 5:26; 1 John 1:7.**
3. His sacrifice was necessary (**Hebrews 9:22; Matthew 26:28**).
4. However, His blood must be applied (**Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21**).

C. Stanza 2: We glorify His name because He abides with us.

1. For those who receive His salvation, He sweetly abides within them (**Ephesians 3:17; John 14:23**).
2. **Galatians 2:20.**

D. Stanza 3 teaches that we give glory to His name for the salvation available through the cross.

1. "Oh, precious fountain that saves from sin, I am so glad I have entered in; There Jesus *saves* me and *keeps* me clean: Glory to His name."
2. A fountain that *saves* from sin. This represents baptism (**Romans 6:4; Col. 2:12**).
3. *Keeps* me clean: This refers to repentance (**1 John 1:9; Acts 8:22**).
4. We enter the church by obeying the gospel (**Acts 2:47; 1 Cor. 12:13**).

E. Conclusion:

1. The life that we live should bring glory to the Lord (**Matt. 5:16**).
2. We must bear the gospel light to those around us.
