INTRODUCTION:

A. 1. Read: 1 Tim. 6:12-16.

B. Regarding the Text:

1. Paul's charge to Timothy in this passage is serious.
2. Paul invokes the name of Jesus' in order to do this.
 - 1) Jesus' name, but also Jesus' return and His authority.
 - 2) He is the King of kings and Lord of lords.
3. One day, it will be made plainly evident to all.
4. In that day, it will be too late to own Jesus as King if one has not owned Him while here on earth.

DISCUSSION: JESUS IS MY KING BECAUSE...

I. HE IS MY GOD.

A. If you believe in God, we should own Jesus as King, because Jesus is God.

1. **John 1:1; 1 Tim. 3:16.**
2. **John 20:28** Thomas declared it.

B. He was worshipped as God; Luke 24:52 “and they worshipped him.”

C. The only conclusion is that Jesus, the Father, and the Holy Spirit are God!

II. HE IS MY SAVIOR.

A. We need a savior!

1. Because my sins separate me from God (**Isa. 59:2; Rom. 6:23**).
2. I cannot save myself based upon my own merits (**Eph. 2:8**).
3. This was told in **Matt. 1:21**.
4. It was announced in **Luke 2:11**.
5. John the Baptizer (**John 1:29**).

B. He brought the light (John 1:1-5; John 8:12).

C. He brought us to God (1 Pet. 3:18).

III. HE IS MY ALL.

A. I am crucified with Him (Gal. 2:20).

B. He rules through His word today (Matt. 28:18; John 6:68).

C. He gave all for me; and so, I must give all for Him; He is my All!

IV. CONCLUSION:

A. Jesus is my King because...

1. He is my **God**, my **Savior** and my **all**.
2. He is everything to me.
