It Is God's Rainbow...

Does the rainbow stand as a symbol of God's goodness and mercy or has it become the symbol of a perverted lifestyle? The news media and politicians are quick to acknowledge the rainbow flag which has been adopted as an official flag and symbol of the same-sex relationship movement (Including the LGBTQIA).



Most everyone remembers the account of Noah and the universal flood (Genesis chapters 6-9). Mankind had become so sinful that “it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart” (**Genesis 6:6**). We read; “... the

wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually” (**Genesis 6:5**). Due to this wickedness, God announced that He would destroy all that was upon the earth except for Noah and his family. Noah was said to be “... a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God” (**Genesis 6:9**). The universal flood would be used to remove the ungodliness that had overtaken the world. **Genesis 6:5** describes mankind's awful condition; “... that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.” That mind-set describes the condition of the liberal media and liberal politicians.

Following the flood God made a covenant with man, “And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there anymore be a flood to destroy the earth” (**Genesis 9:11**). God describes this chosen lifestyle as an abomination. **YES, HE DOES!** Time and time again the Bible used the word abomination when speaking of this particular sin (**Leviticus 18:22; 20:13**)! The word abomination is defined as, “something disgusting (morally), that is, (as a noun) an abhorrence” (Strong's Hebrew and Greek Dictionary). The apostle Paul, by inspiration, stated that it is “unseemly” and “unrighteous” when same-sex individuals engage in sexual relationships (**Romans 1:26-32**). The word “unseemly” means to engage in that which is shameful and indecent (Strong's Hebrew and Greek Dictionary). Far, too many today are taking the “that's their business, and I will not get involved” attitude or the “live and let live” mind-set! However, it is impossible to ignore and turn a “blind eye” to this lifestyle. Many in today's world have the mistaken idea that the same-sex situation is okay if consenting adults so choose to live. Calling a thing okay will not make it so! “Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter” (**Isaiah 5:20**). This movement, to some degree and in some fashion is storming into all of our lives. Keep in mind that God hates every sort of sin (**Proverbs 16:6**).

God put the rainbow in the sky so that men would remember and acknowledge His power and promise. The rainbow is a thing of beauty. Who of us has not stood in awe of this beautiful display? However, there are those in today's

It brings us to a better understanding of Noah's (**Genesis 9**). But the liberals have now caused it to be a symbol of an
