Attitudes Toward Your Home

Ephesians 6:1-4, “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise; that it may be well with you, and you may live long on the earth. And you fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.”

Family is so very important! All too many children find ‘home’ to be simply a place where they eat and sleep (sometimes). It needs to be much more than that. It needs to be a place of warm acceptance and understanding; a place where we can be absolutely honest with each other; a place of love and affection in spite of any shortcomings and wrongdoings. The home and family is a place to grow up – not merely physically, but emotionally, socially, intellectually, and especially spiritually.

The home and family is a place to develop memories...good memories! Traditions are not deliberately started, they grow. We need to develop good traditions that will strengthen our children and our family for a lifetime.

Your children (and grandchildren) will have an attitude toward home and family. Will it be good, or will it be bad? You can, and will, influence that attitude and the memories that come with their experiences.

Consider the words of this poem written by *Denis Waitley*:

“TAKE A MOMENT TO LISTEN”

Take a moment to listen today,
To what your children are trying to say;
Listen today, whatever you do.
Or they won’t be there to listen to you.
Listen to their problems, listen for their needs,

Praise their smallest triumphs,
Praise their smallest deeds;
Tolerate their chatter, amplify their laughter,
Find out what’s the matter,
Find out what they’re after.
But tell them that you love them, every single night.
And though you scold them be sure you hold them;
Tell them “Everything’s all right;
Tomorrow’s looking bright.
Take a moment to listen today
To what your children are trying to say;
Listen today, whatever you do
And they will come back to listen to you.

As parents (and grandparents) we have an awesome responsibility before us; to raise our children in the way and manor that God expects us to. Consult God’s Word --- it is full of practical advice and instruction. The kind of home you make for your children here on earth will determine whether or not they have a home in Heaven. Make sure that they have a good home, good training, and good memories and when they leave it, they will long for every opportunity to come back to visit mom and dad (grandma and grandpa, too).
