## ***Neglecting Salvation.***

In **Hebrews 2:1-4**, we read of neglecting salvation. This means that a lack of sufficient attention is given to salvation. Notice that salvation was first spoken by the Lord (**verse 3**).

If we want to know what to do to be saved, we must go to the Lord's words — not the words of Abraham, Moses, or John the Baptist. Nor should we look for salvation in the words of Joseph Smith (Mormonism) Ellen G. White (Adventism) or Mary Baker Eddy (Christian Scientist). Jesus had the words of eternal life (**John 6:68**). He still does. Men must be taught the Lord's words (John 6:44-45). Men must receive that same word (**James 1:21**). When men neglect the Lord's words, they neglect salvation. There is a great danger in neglecting our salvation.

First, we can become hardened by sin (**Hebrews 3:12-13**). For a picture of how hardened a heart can become, read **Hebrews 6:4-6**. Remember: Paul once said the Gentiles were "past feeling" (**Ephesians 4:19**).

Second, how can we escape the judgment of condemnation? We know there will be a judgment (**Hebrews 9:27**). Paul tells us that we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ (**2 Corinthians 5:10**). Neglecting salvation is to endanger our souls.

Third, how can we escape God's wrath (**Hebrews 10:31**)? People who are impenitent have God's wrath facing them (**Romans 2:4-10**). The Bible still teaches that there is a hell (**Mark 9:43**). To neglect salvation is to face God's wrath.

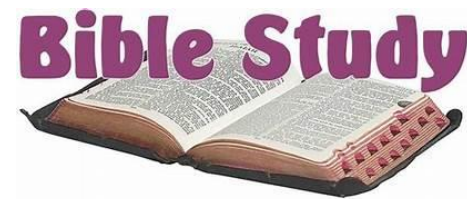
Why do people neglect salvation? Because some of them are deceived by sin. Some are too proud to admit their need for God. Others seem to be looking for a "convenient season." And some (perhaps most) feel they are the exception. A great majority feel they have plenty of time to make things right with God. **James 4:13-14** shows this just may not be true. "The saddest words of tongue or pen may possibly be: 'It might have

been.'" Too much is at stake for anyone to neglect salvation. The Christian life is too wonderful not to live it. Heaven is too great for anyone to miss. Hell is too horrible to endure. And too many people can be led to the Lord by you!! Please give heed and do not neglect your salvation.

## ***The Preaching Of Jesus.***

"From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (**Matt 4:17**). Today, some sins are considered "respectable" and simply the lifestyle of a person. Jesus was kind and sympathetic to the tempted and needy, but sin was never condoned. He condemned the corrupt heart, "Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity" (**Matt 23:28**). He called upon men to change their lives. Again, notice **Matthew 4:17**; "...began to preach, and to say, REPENT..." Repentance is not just a change of mind, it is the turning away from sin. One may change his mind concerning an action and never correct the wrong. The prodigal son came home and said, "I have sinned against heaven and in thy sight" (**Luke 15:21**). He did not place an "IF" before the confession. He did not say "If I have sinned and have done wrong forgive me." He said "I HAVE SINNED..."

The preaching of Jesus included the command to repentance. It must be obeyed by everyone (Luke 13:3, 5). Repentance is an essential factor in the process of obeying the gospel "And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem" (**Luke 24:47**).
