INTRODUCTION:

- A. Read the text: **Genesis 6:9**** “These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.”.
- B. Regarding the text.**
 - 1. What does it mean to walk with God?
 - 2. We are walking toward eternity, so I must know how and where to walk (**Matthew 7:13-14**).

I. A LIFE IN CHRIST.

- A. The Bible speaks of men “walking with God.”**
 - 1. Enoch (**Gen. 5:24. Heb. 11:5** “He pleased God.”)
 - 2. Noah (**Gen. 6:9** “But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.”)
- B. Walking with God means Fellowship, Friendship, and Companionship.**
 - 1. This requires WALKING in TRUTH (**1 John 1:5-7**).
 - 2. Zacharias and Elizabeth: **Luke 1:6** “And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.”
 - 3. Walking with God means to walk in truth. **Psalms 86:11** “Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.”
- C. We must walk with our master.**
 - 1. We are to be disciples. A disciple is a learner, a follower, one who seeks to please his master.
 - 2. There can be but one master (**Luke 16:13** “No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other; or else he will hold to the one and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.”)
 - 3. To walk with our master requires obedience to Him.

II. WALKING WITH THE LORD IS A LIFE OF SERVICE!

- A. Christ lived a life of service. (A life of doing what His Father.)**
 - 1. **John 17:4** “I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.”
 - 2. **John 4:34** “Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.”
- B. It should not be hard for us to be the Lord’s servant. The kind of master one has makes the difference!**
 - 1. Jesus, our master is not a hard taskmaster.
 - 2. **Matt. 11:28-30** “Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.”

III. CONCLUSION: O MASTER LET ME WALK WITH THEE...

- A. To walk with the Lord, I must obey the gospel (**Romans 1:16**).**
- B. We must hear the gospel (**Romans 10:17**); We must believe the gospel (**Mark 16:15-16**); We must confess that Christ is the Son of God (**Romans 10:9-10**); We must repent of our sins (**Acts 8:22; 1 John 1:9**); Then be baptized for the remission of our sins (**Acts 2:38**). After that we must be faithful till death (**Revelation 2:10**).**
