“If”

IF a man can be saved outside the church of Christ, then why did Christ die for the church (Acts 20:28)?

IF a man can be saved and not assemble with the church, then why are we commanded not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together (Hebrews 10:25)?

IF a person can be saved without faith, then why did the writer of the book of Hebrews teach a person must have faith in order to please God (Hebrews 11:6)?

IF people can become Christians by simply believing, then why was King Agrippa, not a Christian (Acts 26:27-28)?

IF a man can be saved without baptism, then why is it commanded (Acts 10:47-48)?

IF sprinkling and pouring constitute scriptural baptism, then why did the apostle Paul say there is ONE baptism, and it is a BURIAL (Ephesians 4:4-6; Romans 6:1-6; Colossians 2:11-12)?
