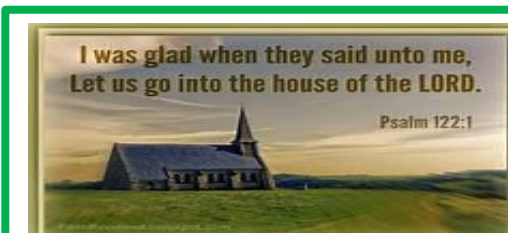

The Reality of God

Is there a God? The world is divided between those who believe in God and those who do not. Who is right? What leads us to believe there is a God? By observation, we can know that a powerful force created this universe. We know because something cannot come from nothing. The Bible says that God has given evidence of Himself to the world (Rom. 1:19). Then it says, “since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made” (Rom. 1:20). Creation demands a Creator.

We can set our watches and clocks by the Naval Observatory. But who is the author of time? Design demands a designer. Jesus said, “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end” (Rev. 22:13). “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made” (John 1:1-3).

If we go too fast around a curve, we will lose control and go off the road due to the laws of physics. Who made that law? Laws demand that there be a Lawgiver. James 4:12 says, “There is only one Lawgiver”. Jehovah set in place all laws of nature; “It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in” (Isa. 40:22).

The law of biogenesis means that life can only come from life. Therefore, Life demands a life giver. God said that everything reproduces after its own kind - including vegetation, plants, animals, and human beings (Gen. 1:11, 24). All living things will eventually die. Yet man will not cease to exist for “God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into His nostrils the breath of life and man became a living being” (Gen. 2:7). “In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust

shalt thou return” (Gen. 3:19). “All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust” (Job 34:15).

With these facts in mind, who would dare declare that there is no God? (Adapted)

God's Word of Truth

The truth of God's word is found in the Bible. Jesus says in John 8:32, “And you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free.” Only the truth that is found in God's word can make us free from sin, so we can be saved. God wants all people to be saved. 1 Timothy 2:4 says concerning God, “Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.” Before one can be saved, one must first come to a knowledge of God's truth.

However, there are many people today who do not want to know the truth. 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 states that many will “... received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.” Why will they be condemned? Because one cannot obey the truth until one first believes it.

Many people, as 2 Timothy 3:7, are “Always learning and never able to come to a knowledge of the truth.” Why aren't they able to come to a knowledge of the truth? Because as Romans 1:25 says, “changed the truth of God into a lie...” And as in 2 Timothy 4:4, they “turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.” Why are so many people turning from the truth? 2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 says, “God will send them strong delusion that they would believe a lie, that they might all be damned who believe not the truth.” The world is saturated with religious lies that are going to cause the majority of people to be lost forever in the burning fires of Hell (Matthew 7:13-14). So, it is a very serious matter that we know, believe, and obey only God's truth. One cannot be saved unless he does so. People must read and follow their instruction manual (the Bible) on how to go to heaven. (Ron Boatright)
