God's Plan For Unity

A great leader in missionary work once said, "We are defeated before we begin by our divisions!" A follower of Mohammed once declared to an American missionary, "Christianity can never hope to conquer Islamism till your missionaries can agree upon what Christianity is."

How true these statements are! In the days of the apostles the church was one (Acts 4:32). And now, the so-called Christian world owes it to God and to an unbelieving world to pray and study until it finds the pure teachings of Christianity as in the beginning, am then with a united voice present that, and only that, to the whole world. God has already laid a foundation for Christian unity in His Word that is simple, perfect, and practical.

To the Christians at Ephesus, the Apostle Paul admonished: "Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all who is above all, and through all, and in you all" (Eph. 4:3-6).

There are seven "ones" in God's platform for unity:

1. One Body: Unity of Organization. The body is the church (Eph. 1:22,23; Col. 1:24; I Cor. 12:20). Christ promised to build but one church (Matt. 16:18).
2. One Spirit: Unity of Revelation. The Holy Spirit revealed the truth (John 16:13; Eph. 3:5). All so-called revelations that differ from the Bible are false.
3. One Hope: Unity of Aim. The hope of every Christian is eternal life in heaven (Mark 10:30; Titus 1:2; 1 John 2:25).
4. One Lord: Unity of Authority. Christ now has all authority in heaven and on earth (Matt. 28:18). He alone is the head of the church (Col. 1:18). There can be unity only in submission to him.

5. One Faith: Unity of Doctrine. Guided by the Holy Spirit, the apostles all taught the same doctrine, emphasizing that there is only one true gospel.
6. (Gal. 1:8,9; Jude 3). Unity can be attained only by uniting upon the one faith.
7. One baptism: Unity of Practice. Practically all religious leaders practice something they call baptism. The Bible plainly tells us what baptism is, what it is for, and who is a proper subject of it. Scriptural baptism is a burial in water (Rom. 6:3,4; Col. 2:12); and unto a penitent believer, following his confession of faith in Christ (Acts 8:36-39), it is for (unto) the remission of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38)
8. One God-Unity of Worship. The Father has revealed in his Word how men are to worship him. We are to worship "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24; 17:17). The New Testament reveals these five simple items, or acts of Christian worship:
 - 1) Singing (Eph. 5:18,19; Col. 3:16).
 - 2) Eating the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7; I Cor. 11:23,24).
 - 3) Teaching God's Word (Acts 2:42).
 - 4) Contributing money (I Cor. 16:2).
 - 5) Praying (Acts 2:42) to God through Christ, the Christian's only mediator.
