INTRO.:

 - 3. Here are just a few of those promises we hold dear.

- A. James 1:17** "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."
 - 1. His promises are unchanging. The illusion is due to the constant changing shadows as the sun moves across the sky.
 - 2. This unchanging promise is essential to our faith (**Rev. 22:18-19; John 12:48**).
