INTRO.:

A. Read Text: Genesis 17:1.

B. Regarding the text:

1. God is many things.
2. Some say that there are two Gods, one in the Old Testament and one in the New Testament (**Malachi 3:6; Hebrews 13:8**).

I. GOD IS ALWAYS RIGHT.

- A. Deuteronomy 32:4** “He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.”
- B. God is always right (Psalm 19:7-9** “The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.”)
- C. He is right even when it doesn’t make sense to men (John 3:3** “...Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”)
- D. Our wisest thought is foolishness to God (1 Corinthians 1:25** “Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.”)

II. GOD IS ALWAYS GOOD.

- A. Psalm 25:8-10** “Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way. The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way. All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.”
- B. God was good in the Old Testament (Psalm 52:1** “... the goodness of God endureth continually.”)
- C. God is good in the New Testament (Romans 2:4** “Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?”)
- D. The fact that tragedy happens doesn’t mean that God is not good.**

III. GOD IS ALWAYS LOVE.

- A. 1 John 4:8** “He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.”, **16** “... God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.”
- B. His love is the greatest ever known (John 3:16).**
- C. His love is unconditional (Romans 5:8).**
- D. God’s love is demonstrated (1 John 4:10).**
