INTRO.:

A. Read text: John 6:44-45.

B. Regarding the text:

1. People can be drawn to a church, a preacher, or other things.
 - 1) Suppers, games, parties, etc., will draw people to the church.
 - 2) Charisma and sensationalism will draw people to the preacher.
2. However, people can be drawn to Jesus in only one way – “**Except** ...”
3. Let us answer two questions about being drawn to Jesus:

I. WHY SHOULD WE BE DRAWN TO JESUS?

A. He is the one sent from God (John 6:44; John 3:16).

B. He is the source of everlasting life (John 6:27, 35, 40, 44, 47-50, 66-68).

C. He is our redeemer (Titus 2:14 “Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity...”)

D. He is Lord and Christ (Acts 2:36 “Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.” Supreme authority & the Messiah).

1. At “right hand of God” as head and king (Acts 2:29-33).
2. As Lord, King, and Head, he is to control our lives.

II. HOW ARE WE DRAWN TO JESUS?

A. By hearing and learning (John 6:45 “It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.”)

1. **2 Thessalonians 2:14** “Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.:
2. **2 Timothy 2:15; Psalm 119:11.**
3. Then by obeying Jesus in all things (**Hebrews 5:9**).

B. By believing and taking the PROPER action.

1. Just believing He is our Lord is not enough (**Matthew 7:21-23**).
2. Action is required of us (**Acts 2:37-38**).

III. CONCLUSION:

A. We must allow ourselves to be drawn to the Lord. He will not force us to come to Him. Matt. 11:28 “Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.”

B. Many resist the word and try to do things their way, rather than obeying the word of God.
