INTRO.:

- A. Read text: **2 Pet. 2:5.**
- B. Noah is an example of faithfulness even though he lived in a world of wickedness.

I. WE ARE SAVED BY GRACE.

- A. Noah (**Gen. 6:8** "But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.")
- B. You and I (**Eph. 2:8** "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God." **Rom. 6:23**)

II. BY FAITH.

- A. Noah (**Heb. 11:7** "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house...").
- B. You and I (**Heb. 11:6** "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, **and** that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." **Rom. 1:17** "For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.")

III. BY OBEDIENCE.

- A. Noah (**Heb. 11:7** "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith." **Gen. 6:22** "Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.")
- B. You and I (**Heb. 5:8-9** "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him." **Matt. 7:21** ("Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.")

IV. BY WATER.

- A. Noah (**1 Peter 3:20** "Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.")
- B. You and I (**John 3:3-5** "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." **1 Pet. 3:21** "The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.") Can we deny the need for water in our salvation?

V. CONCLUSION:

- B. How do we make that a reality? In the manner in which Noah was saved.
 - 1. By God's grace; by faith; by obedience; and by having sins washed away through baptism.
