INTRODUCTION:

A. Hebrews 1:1-3.

1. He has spoken!
2. God has given us His instructions.
 - 1) We cannot direct our own steps (**Jeremiah 10:23**).
 - 2) Thus, we must conform to His ways (**Romans 12:1-2; Ephesians 2:1-3**).

B. God's word must order our steps (Psalm 37:23 “The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.”)

I. GOD HAS SPOKEN, “IN TIME PAST BY THE PROPHETS.”

A. Prophets were God's spokesmen.

B. God spoke directly to them at different times and in various ways.

1. Moses and the burning bush.
2. God spoke to the world through Noah.
3. God spoke to Israel through various prophets.
 - 1) Prophets moved by the Holy Spirit (**2 Peter 1:19-21**).
 - 2) David (**Acts 1:16**).
 - 3) The prophets spoke of Israel's captivity (**Jeremiah 29:10** fulfilled in **Ezra 1:1**).

II. GOD HAS SPOKEN, “IN THESE LAST DAYS BY HIS SON”.

A. Christ was the ultimate and ideal prophet (Deuteronomy 18:15-18; Acts 3:22,23; 7:37).

B. Christ spoke personally and representatively (Heb. 2:3,4)

1. He sent apostles to help in the work of revelation. (
 - 1) **John 14:26** “But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.”
 - 2) **John 16:13** “Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak and he will shew you things to come.”
2. He gave them power to impart spiritual gifts to early churches (**Mark 16:20**).

C. Christ was God's final spokesman.

1. Jude indicates that the revelation is complete (**Jude 3** “... earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.”).
2. Modern claims of direct revelation are a direct challenge to this truth.
3. There are no new revelations (**Galatians 1:6-10** “I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.”)
4. There can be no changing what God has spoken (**Revelation 22:18-19**).

III. CONCLUSION:

A. God has spoken. We have His message in written form.

B. Written for us (2 Tim. 2:15; 3:16-17).

C. God has spoken. The question is, will we listen?

1. Will we listen?
2. Do we demand more?
