"And with him they crucify two thieves: the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors" (Mark 15:27-28).

One died in his sins.
One died with his sin forgiven.
One died for the sins of the world.

The Cross Of Christ – Its Message.

1 Corinthians 1:7-8 “For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.”

Many are moving away from the message of salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ. They are replacing the message of the cross of Christ with one that has no power to save.

THE PROPHECIES OF THE CROSS:

The first promise of the cross is found in **Genesis 3:15**. Adam and Eve had sinned and thus were separated from God (**Isaiah 59:1-2; John 9:31**). To be away from God is to be lost. Therefore, God promised to send one who would come between man and his sin.

THE PURPOSE OF THE CROSS:

Even though the cross of Christ reveals great pain, suffering, anguish, and ridicule, Jesus went to Golgotha and martyrdom to give mankind forgiveness and eternal hope (**John 3:16; Romans 5:7-8**). That “old rugged cross” was to make way for eternal salvation (**John 14:6; Hebrews 9:22**). In the Old Testament, it was the blood of animals that was offered (**Leviticus 10:4**). However, those blood sacrifices did not have the power to remove sins (**Hebrews 10:4**). If the blood of animals could be an atonement for sin, Christ would not have had to endure the crucifixion. Our cleansing from sin required the precious blood of Jesus (**Romans 6:23**).

The cross of Christ would also bring the Old Testament Law to an end (**Colossians 2:14**). Jesus is the mediator of a “new testament” (**Hebrews 9:15-17**). **Isaiah 2:1-3** informs us that “the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.” He told the disciples that “repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, *beginning at Jerusalem*” (**Luke 24:46-47**).

The cross of Christ defeated Satan. Our ability to overcome the devil was promised in **Genesis 3:15**. Because of sin, Christ would die on the cross, thereby coming between man and sin: “And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” Satan must have rejoiced in his supposed victory when Jesus said, “When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head and gave up the ghost” (**John 19:30**). However, “It is finished” did not signify His death. It proclaimed the fulfillment of His soul-saving work (**Luke 19:10; Romans 5:6**). Jesus said, *IT* is finished, not *I* am finished. The Savior was buried, rose from the grave, and ascended into heaven, where He now sits “at the right hand of the throne of God” (**Hebrews 12:2**). The cruel cross proclaims victory over sin!

THE PRODUCT OF THE CROSS:

When the power of the cross is applied, three great and wonderful things take place.

Sin is destroyed. When we place our faith in the shed blood of Jesus, we are forever changed. The chains of sin are broken (**Romans 6:14**), and we become a new creature (**2 Corinthians 5:17**). The newborn believer need not live in the bondage of sin (**Romans 6:6**). The blood of the Lamb has the power to transform every life it cleanses. There truly is “wonder-working power in the blood of the Lamb!”

Hell is defeated. Those who have been cleansed by Christ’s blood and who remain faithful will not experience the fires of hell. Thanks be to the Lord for the precious blood that has defeated the agony of an eternal hell.

The cross of Christ opened the door to heaven. This life-giving blood is the key that opens the gates of glory. This is the promised reward for every faithful child of God (**John 14:1-3**). And there is “only one way to the pearly gates” (**John 3:3, 5, 7**).

Have you been to Jesus for the cleansing power? Are you washed in the blood of the Lamb? (This is our only hope for eternal life!)
