DADDY, WHEN WE DIE, WILL WE GO TO HEAVEN?

“Daddy, how many nickels are in a dollar? How do birds fly? When we die, will we go to Heaven?”

I am sure most, if not all, of us have seen the commercial in which a little boy asks his daddy a series of questions. The dad is very quick to answer all but the final one. He looks puzzled, and the ad tells us to watch the 700 Club for the answer. The 700 Club is a denominational television program hosted by Pat Robertson. The number “700” comes from Robertson’s first televised telethon for his ministry. In it, he set a goal of 700 members paying \$10 each a month, a number that would meet the industry’s operating budget at the time. Robertson came to refer to these members as the ‘700 Club,’ and the name stuck.

Just how does the 700 Club answer the little boy’s question? Does Mr. Robertson’s 700 Club answer the little boy’s question accurately? Here is his remedy for sin and going to Heaven. “We must trust Jesus Christ to forgive our sins and receive Him as our Savior and serve Him as our Lord. “As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believed on His name... Would you like to give your life over to Jesus Christ right now? If so, you can pray the following prayer and accept Jesus as your Savior: Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need Your forgiveness. I believe that You died on the cross for my sins and rose from the grave to give me life. I know You are the only way to God. So now I want to quit disobeying You and start living for You. Please forgive me, change my life, and show me how to know You. In Jesus’ name. Amen.” (Quote from CBN <https://www1.cbn.com/stepstopeace/>). Our question... If the little boy and his daddy call the 700 Club as is suggested, will they find the correct answer to life’s most important question? Absolutely NOT!

When we die, will we go to heaven? Surely, we understand this is the greatest question that men can ask! It is much more important than “what can I do to be rich, to be healthy, or to be popular.” “For what is a man profited if he shall gain the whole world and lose his own soul?”

(Matthew 16:26). If one is seriously looking for the answer to this question, they must go to the book which gives the correct answer. God’s word gives us “all things that pertain to life and godliness” (2 Peter 1:3).

On the day of Pentecost in Acts 2, when asked: “... Men and brethren, what shall we do?” Peter answered, “Repent and be baptized...” (Acts 2:37-38). Then notice what is said in verse 40, “And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.” How could they save themselves? By doing the work which God had “before ordained” (Ephesians 2:10). Paul said in Philippians 2:12, “Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.” The Hebrew writer stated, “And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him” (Hebrews 5:9). How do we obey Him? By DOING the things which He has commanded. Did you know that our love for the Lord is demonstrated by obedience (doing as He commands)? 1 John 5:3, “For this is the love of God that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.” John 14:15 “If ye love me, keep my commandments.” 2 John 1:6 “And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, that, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.”

God’s plan for going to heaven is clear and concise.

1. **Hear the gospel of Christ** (Romans 10:17; 1:16; Acts 2:37).
2. **Believe the teaching of the gospel** (Mark 16:15-16; Hebrews 11:6; Romans 10:13-17).
3. **Repent of sins** (Acts 2:38; Luke 13:3-5; 24:46-49).
4. **Confess** (John 6:68-69; Acts 8:36-37; 1 John 4:15).
5. **Be baptized for the remission of sins** (Acts 2:38-41; 22:16).
6. **Live faithfully unto death** (Rev. 2:10; 1 John 1:5-9).

Do you want to know the answer to life’s greatest question? Go to the word of God and obey Him (Hebrews 5:9). The answer to life’s greatest question is found in God’s word, NOT the 700 Club!
