INTRODUCTION:

- A. The Lord's Supper is a monument to the body and blood of Jesus Christ.**
- B. We are to remember His death for remission of our sins.**

DISCUSSION: IN THIS STUDY WE WILL OBSERVE...

I. JESUS INSTITUTED THE LORD'S SUPPER.

- A. Matthew 26:17-30.**
- B. Also Mark 14:12-25; Luke 22:7-30; 1 Cor. 11:17-34.**
- C. Place to be taken (Acts 20:7). “In my Father’s kingdom” (Matthew 26:29).**
- D. The First Century Christians are an example of observing the Lord's Supper?**
 - 1. **Acts 20:7.**
 - 2. To be taken *EVERY* first day of the week.
 - 3. To be taken with the saints who were assembled together.
 - 1) **Hebrews 10:25.**
 - 2) It was to be taken in the assembly (**1 Corinthians 11:20, 33-34**).

II. THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SUPPER

- A. A memorial in memory of Jesus (1 Corinthians 11:24-6).**
 - 1. In memory of the greatest PERSON (**1 Peter 2:22; 1 John 3:5**).
 - 2. To remember the greatest sacrifice (**Hebrews 10:4**).
- B. We declare that Christ will come again (1 Corinthians 11:26).**
- C. If I absent myself from this memorial, what does it say about myself?**
 - 1. I proclaim that His sacrifice is not important to me.
 - 2. I show others that there is something more important to me than Jesus!
- D. A time of examination.**
 - 1. **1 Corinthians 11:27-29.**
 - 1) Partake in a worthy manner (**27**). Remembering Jesus and what He did with His body for us (**Isa. 53:7-8**)
 - 2) “Unworthy” means irreverently (**29**).
 - 2. Focus on the sacrifice made for our salvation.

III. THE DAY AND THE FREQUENCY OF THE OBSERVANCE OF THE LORD'S SUPPER.

- A. Acts 20:7 (FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK).**
 - 1. There are 52 weeks; therefore, there are 52 *FIRST DAYS OF THE WEEK*.
 - 2. Every first day of the week.
- B. No other day will do!**

IV. THE ELEMENTS.

- A. The Lord instituted the Lord's Supper on the Feast of the Passover. (Matthew 26:17).**
 - 1. The Passover bread was unleavened (**Exodus 12:20**).
 - 2. The unleavened bread properly symbolizes the purity of our Saviour.
- B. The fruit of the vine (Matthew 26:29) symbolizes His blood shed for the sins of mankind. The element is to be grape juice. It is NOT to be alcoholic. It is to be the juice of the vine (No leavening).**

V. CONCLUSION:

- A. The Lord’s Supper is to be an act of worship.**
- B. “This do in remembrance of Me!”**
