INTRODUCTION:

A. Text: 1 Timothy 6:13-16.

B. Regarding the text:

1. Paul's charge to Timothy in this passage is serious.
 - 1) The charge is given in the sight of God.
 - 2) The charge is given also in the sight of Christ.
 - 3) **John 18:33-37.**
2. His authority is made known through study and acceptance of God's word.
 - 1) Many today will not accept Him as their King!
 - 2) One day, it will be understood by all men.
 - 3) In that day, it will be too late to own Jesus as King.

C. Why should we own Jesus as King today and what does that mean?

DISCUSSION: JESUS IS MY KING BECAUSE . . .

I. HE HAS ALL AUTHORITY.

A. The Father declared this fact (Matthew 17:5).

B. He is King of Kings (1 Timothy 6:15).

1. Only Potentate: Translated as authority in **Acts 8:27.**
2. King of Kings Lord of Lords: Far above any king or lord on the earth.

C. This King has all authority (Hebrews 1:1- 4; Romans 1:4).

D. It is important to recognize Him as King of King (Rev. 17:14).

II. HE IS MY SAVIOR.

A. I need a savior. I do sin from time to time (Isa. 59:2; Rom. 6:23).

B. Scripture declares that He is our Savior.

1. It was revealed to **Joseph (Matthew 1:21).**
2. Spoken to the **shepherds (Luke 2:11).**
3. Announced by **John the Baptizer (John 1:29).**

C. He came to save all men (John 3:16; 1 Timothy 4:10-14; 2 Timothy 1:8-11).

D. By His sacrifice, we are healed (Isaiah 53:5; 1 Peter 2:24).

III. HE IS MY EVERYTHING.

A. He is my Savior; he is my all (Romans 14:9)!

B. I will be His servant (Romans 6:18).

C. I will live by and under His rule (Matthew 28:18; Hebrews 9:15).

D. I want to be in His kingdom which is His church (Matthew 16:18; Colossians 1:13). This is done by obeying the gospel (Acts 2:37-47).

E. He gave all for me. I must give my all for Him. He is my everything, He is my All!
